The challenges of traditional cleansing routines

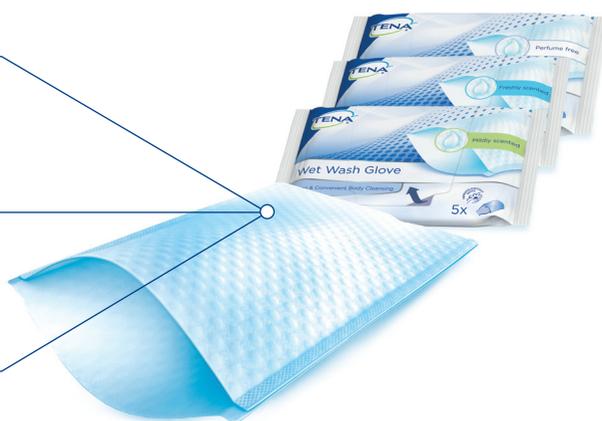
